ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcon MCC will promote a Club Restricted Trial on 22/04/18 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Huddersfield Falcon MCC. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration/Membership card or a SACU licence or ACU / SACU rider's license. Any rider or passenger from another FMN must produce a Licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance. These must be available for inspection on request.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

CLASSES: Experts, Intermediates, Novices, Beginners, T/Shock, O/40's, O/60s, Pre. 65 and Youth A, B, C & D.
There will be 4 courses to choose from – Championship (Hard), Clubman A (50/50), Clubman B (Easy) plus a White (Dead Easy) Route.

START / VENUE: - 11.00 a.m. at High Bank Quarry, High Bank Lane, THURLSTONE, near Penistone, Sheffield, S36 9QH –

ENTRIES / FEE: **Entry on the Day only** - Entries must be on the completed Club's Standard entry form appended to these Regulations (or available to download from the website), along with the **ENTRY FEE OF £15.00* PER RIDER**, (plus Falcon Club membership of £5 for 2018 if not already paid) and should be submitted to the TRIAL SECRETARY up to 1 hour before Start. ***(£5.00 for aged 16 and under)**

CHEQUES PAYABLE TO HUDDERSFIELD FALCON MCC PLEASE.

Please include a SAE if you require posted results, otherwise they will be published on our web site - www.falconmcc.co.uk

AWARDS: The outright winner on each course will be awarded a £5.00 (equivalent) voucher on each trial, class winners will receive a £3.00 voucher; in both cases providing a minimum 3 riders take part. Other awards may be awarded at the Organiser's discretion.

Points for the Championship are awarded for finishing positions in each class for each event. Overall class winners will be decided on the best eight rounds with a minimum number of six rounds required to count.

NB. ALL AWARDS TO BE MADE AT THE YEAR END FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2019.

COURSE: - All on private land and will generally be a minimum of 4 laps of eight or ten sections (to be decided on the day). There will be 4 courses to choose from – Hard, 50/50, Easy, plus a Dead Easy (White) route - first section will close by 3.00pm at the latest by the Observer pulling out the course markers. Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22b; stop NOT permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23. Failure to attempt a section will incur a 10 mark penalty in accordance with ACU Rules; alternatively you can incur a 5 mark penalty, but only if you request this off the Observer rather than attempt the section (this ruling applies to closed-to-club trials only). To be classified as a finisher riders must attempt at least 75% of the sections.

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.

PLEASE NOTE: -

- ACU Licences and Club Membership Cards must be available for inspection on request.
- Parking is limited at this venue; please share transport wherever possible.
- DO NOT CAUSE OBSTRUCTION TO NON-COMPETING TRAFFIC WHEN PARKING.
- Do not return to this venue for practise purposes and **no** practising before or after the event.
