SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcon MCC will promote a Club Restricted Trial for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Huddersfield Falcon MCC. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration /Membership or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance. (Registrations will be checked at signing on).

COVID 19: Individuals need to take responsibility for their own safety and exercise judgement as appropriate.

The event will be run under the current recommendations issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to. Anyone who has contracted coronavirus, exhibited symptoms, been in contact with someone who has been infected with the virus, or requested to self-isolate in a ten-day period prior to the event taking place shall not travel to or participate/officiate at the event and will follow Gov.UK guidance/advice as appropriate.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.
CLASSES: Novices, Beginners, T/Shock, O40's, Pre. 65 and Youth A, B, C & D (including electric bikes). There will be 2 courses to choose from – Easy & Dead Easy!

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES WILL BE 6.00pm ON FRIDAY 21st. OCTOBER (NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY) ENTRY FEE OF £16.00 / £8.00 (ADULTS / Youths 16 and under), plus Falcon Club membership of £5* for 2022 if not already paid, to be made electronically. At the time of entry you will need to take out ACU Trial Registration / Licence if you haven't already done so (ONE DAY LICENCES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE). *Club Membership can be paid online also Note in the event of cancellation of event or a rider cancelling their entry the ACU will make a £3 surcharge for each rider entered via the ACU Event Entry System.

RESULTS: - Will be e-mailed to Competitors who provide an e-mail address, as well as being published on the Club's "Facebook" page and web site <u>www.falconmcc.co.uk</u> and other public domains.

AWARDS: The winner of the Dead Easy Course at the end of the Series will be awarded the Michael Rock Memorial Trophy. The outright winner on each course will be awarded a £5.00 (equivalent) voucher on each trial, class winners will receive a £3.00 voucher; in both cases providing a minimum 3 riders take part. Other awards may be awarded at the Organiser's discretion. Points for the Championship are awarded for finishing positions in each class for each event. Overall class winners will be decided on the best 4 results. NB. SOUVENIR TROPHY AWARDS MAY BE MADE AT THE NEXT FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2023.

COURSE: - All on private land and will generally be a minimum of 4 laps of eight or ten sections (to be decided on the day). There will be 2 courses to choose from – Easy & Dead Easy - first section will close by 3.00pm at the latest by the Observer pulling out the course markers. Sections shall generally be ridden in correct order on each lap, subject to queuing qualification above. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

NOTE: Juniors riders, and their Guardian (if also competing), will be permitted to complete all the laps through any section "in one hit" to minimise unnecessary repeat travel between sections.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22b; No Stop. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23. Failure to attempt a section will incur a 10 mark penalty in accordance with ACU Rules; alternatively you can incur a 5 mark penalty, but only if you request this off the Observer rather than attempt the section (this ruling applies to closed-to-club trials only).

To be classified as a finisher riders must attempt at least 75% of the sections.

PROTESTS: - any appeal situation can only be dealt with electronically after the event, under National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04. *****£10.00 EXPENSES PAID TO ALL OBSERVERS*****
