ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcon MCC will promote a Club Restricted Trial on 30/01/12 for solo motorcycles, with classes for:- Experts, Intermediates, Novices, Beginners, Twinshock, O40's, Pre-65 and Youth A, B, C
This is the FIRST round of the Club Championship series.

JURISDICTION: - The event will be run under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Huddersfield Falcon MCC. All riders must hold a current ACU registration card or SACU license. Other riders must produce a license and start permission confirming insurance from their Federation

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

AWARDS: Points for the Championship are awarded for finishing positions in each class for each event.

ALL SIX ROUNDS TO COUNT.

NB. ALL AWARDS TO BE MADE AT THE YEAR END FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2013.

COURSE: - All on private land and will generally be a minimum of 4 laps of eight or ten sections (to be decided on the day). There will be 4 courses to choose from – Hard, 50/50 and Easy course, with a course-closing time of 3.00pm at the latest.

Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22a (stop permitted). Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04
