1st. Round Novice & Beginners Club Championship

DATE: Sunday 26th. February 2012

ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcon MCC will promote a Club Restricted Trial on 26/02/12 for solo motorcycles, with classes for: - Nov, Beginners, T/Shock, O40's, Pre. 65 and Youth A, B, C, D. This is the FIRST round of the Club's Novice and Beginners Championship series.

JURISDICTION: - The event will be run under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Huddersfield Falcon MCC. All riders must hold a current ACU registration card or SACU license. Other riders must produce a license and start permission confirming insurance from their Federation

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

START / VENUE: - 11.00 a.m. at KIRBY WOOD, FLOCKTON, near WAKEFIELD – off A637 between Emley and Flockton villages (O/S Map Ref 110/245145). No engines to be run before start time or until instructed.

ENTRIES / FEE: Entries must be on the completed Club's Standard entry form appended to these Regulations (or available to download from the website), along with the ENTRY FEE OF £12 PER RIDER, (plus Falcon Club membership of £5 for 2012 if not already paid) and should be submitted to the TRIAL SECRETARY up to 1 hour before Start.

CHEQUES PAYABLE TO HUDDERSFIELD FALCON MCC PLEASE.

Please include a SAE if you require posted results, otherwise they will be published on our web site - www.falconmcc.co.uk

AWARDS: Points for the Championship are awarded for finishing positions in each class for each event. Overall class winners will be decided on the best five rounds with a minimum number of three rounds required.

NB. ALL AWARDS TO BE MADE AT THE YEAR END FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2013.

COURSE: - All on private land and will generally be a minimum of 4 laps of eight or ten sections (to be decided on the day). There will be 4 courses to choose from – hard, 50/50 easy course and white, (with a course-closing time of 3.30pm at the latest)

Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22a; stop permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23. Failure to attempt a section will incur a 10 mark penalty in accordance with ACU Rules; alternatively you can incur a 5 mark penalty, but only if you request this off the Observer rather than attempt the section – this ruling applies to closed-to-club trials only. To be classified as a finisher riders must attempt at least 75% of the sections.

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.

- Do not return to this venue for practise purposes and **no** practising before or after the event.
