Supplementary Regulations

ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcons MCC will organise an 'Open Permit' Trial for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.

ELIGIBILITY: - Open to registered members of the ACU. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration /Membership or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance. (Registrations will be checked at signing on).

COVID 19: *Individuals need to take responsibility for their own safety and exercise judgement as appropriate.*

The event will be run under the current recommendations issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to.

Anyone who has contracted coronavirus, exhibited symptoms, been in contact with someone who has been infected with the virus, or requested to self-isolate in a ten-day period prior to the event taking place shall not travel to or participate/officiate at the event and will follow Gov.UK guidance/advice as appropriate.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

RockShocks CLASSES: - **Pre75, Air-Cooled Monoshock and Twinshock motorcycles (As per Rock Shocks Regulations)**

Greenwood Trophy Classes Britshock (Pre75), Air-Cooled Monoshock and Twinshock motorcycles ridden by anyone over 35 years of age

ENTRY FEE OF £30.00 to be paid electronically. At the time of entry you will need to take out ACU Trial Registration / Licence if you haven't already done so (ONE DAY LICENCES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE).

NOTE: You can cancel your entry online up to the closing date or inform the Trials Secretary by e-mail up to the day before the event.

Note in the event of cancellation of event or a rider cancelling their entry the ACU may make a surcharge for each rider entered but No refunds will be given for no show on the day.

RESULTS: - will be e-mailed to those competitors who provide an e-mail address, published on our website www.falconmcc.co.uk and other public domains including the Falcon Facebook page by the evening of the trial if possible.

AWARDS for the RockShocks Series will be made at the end of the season and presented at the Telford Show

The Greenwood Trophy# Replica Award + £20.00 cash will be awarded for best performance by a competitor aged 35 or over riding on the Main (Red/Blue) Course. 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each Class on either course, an AWARD (subject to at least 3 entries in each class).

(Trophy to be held for one year only).

COURSE: - All on private land, to consist of 2 laps of 20 sections with TWO courses – Expert (Red/Blue flags) and Clubman (Yellow flags).

Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22b (no stop). Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23

PROTESTS: - should be e-mailed to the Organising Club within 7 days of the Results being published; the arbitration of any protests will be reviewed by the Rock-Shocks Classic Trials Championship Organisers, generally as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04
